



UK HEI Collaborations in Malaysia: Subject Areas




Contribution of International Students to the Economy

- > *390,000 students were studying entirely overseas for higher education level awards during the 2008-09 academic year.*
- > *In 2009, the export of higher education contributed £5.3 billion to the UK economy.*
- > *In 2009, 15% of the student population in Britain were international students.*
- > *In 2007/8 the total off-campus expenditure by international students reached £2.3 billion.*
