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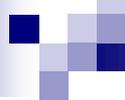

- Needs for social and economic development




Contents of the Outline

- What we will focus on: Policy dialogue; New mechanism for and new form of cooperation

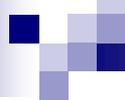
Students Mobility

- Study In China Program (2010)
 - By 2015, 350,000 international students in China per year
 - Higher percentage of degree-seekers and long-term learners in China
 - Improvement of education quality for international students
 - Teacher training and curriculum development

Students Mobility


■ Study Abroad

- Continuance of the policy “Supporting students studying abroad; Encouraging them come back while granting them with freedom for choice”
- By 2015, 30,000 state-sponsored Chinese students annually
- Exploring an open system for talents cultivation: mutual recognition of academic credits and joint degrees between HEI in China and abroad.



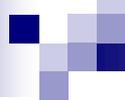
Sino-foreign cooperation in school-running and joint programs

- Guidelines: Enlarging opening up; standardizing education provision; managing in accordance with law; promoting overall development
- Systematic and strategic planning: selective in education providers and regions for cooperation
- Quality Assurance
- New ways and mechanism for cooperation



Talents Recruitment and Teacher Training

- Talents recruitment: excellent scholars and their teams; talents for education management
- Teacher Training: capacity building for head teachers and excellent teachers in primary and secondary schools



Exchanges in Language and Culture

- Chinese language learning as a foreign language: teachers training; textbooks development; China study center
- Cooperation on studying different countries in the world
