
Key Issues

- A willingness to work with schools as partners

Accurate & Timely Information

- Each school is now individually responsible for careers guidance.
- Students need information about course requirements, e.g. Experience in a hospital for medicine applications.
- Schools need information around qualifications required. GCSE choices are made in year 9...in some schools, in year 8.
