










cross-cultural capability

Killick defines cross-cultural capability as the ability 'to communicate effectively across cultures, to see one's discipline and subsequent professional practice in cultural perspective, and to recognise the legitimacy of other cultural practices in both personal and professional life' (Killick, 2009).










Internationalisation at Home: activities that help students develop international understanding and intercultural skills

Internationalisation Abroad: all forms of education across borders, mobility of students, teachers, scholars, programmes, courses, curriculum, projects










Impact on students






Alternative to Study Abroad





15 projects, ten countries across six continents.148 students supported at 50% of costs in 2007










Learning about cultural 'others'








In summary

Effective Internationalisation







