Why do students drop out?

- Wrong choice of course
- Not coping academically or socially
- Lack of support
- Employment/Apprenticeship
- Poor educational experience
- Financial issues
- Lack of confidence in the future
- Bored!

How can we prevent it?

- Right course first time
- Wrap around provision curriculum, support finance
- Identify at risk students
- Implement individual support (PLCs)
- Peer mentoring
- Student focussed teaching
- Retained in college not just course

Re-engaging drop outs

- "Choices Plus"
- Mid year start points
- Avoid stereo types
- Keep in touch with college drop outs
- Culture of "yet to complete" not failure

Improving internal retention and progression between years

- Recognise the reasons for lack of progression
- Identify alternative options and opportunity for course transfer
- Promote and market
- Engage with teaching staff
