PROVIDING CONFIDENCE

Some of QAA's main UK activities today:

- **Review and audit programmes** for universities, further education colleges and private providers
- Adviser to Privy Council on applications for **degree-awarding powers** and university title
- Provider of **Educational Oversight**, on behalf of UK Border Agency, for 'Highly Trusted Sponsor' status for institutions with overseas students
- ***UK Quality Code for Higher Education***



THE NEW *UK QUALITY CODE FOR HIGHER EDUCATION*

- Replaces the *Academic Infrastructure*
- For the first time, includes new chapters on:
 - *Learning & Teaching*
 - *Student Engagement*
 - *Student Support*
 - *Information about Higher Education*
- Published in chapters, following consultation
- First chapters released December 2011
- Complete *Code* to be published by end of 2013

- New formal requirement for higher education – **Key Information Sets (KIS)**
- QAA will make formal judgements on information provision from September 2012
- Information must be:
 - Fit for purpose
 - Accessible
 - Trustworthy
