

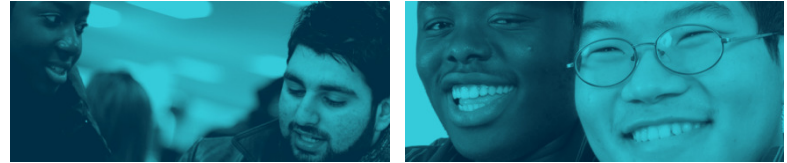

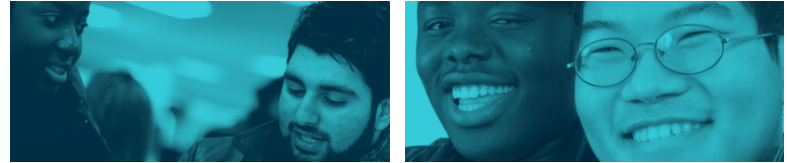

- lack of coherent national policy on international students



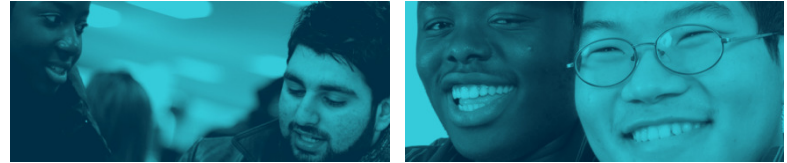
The global context

Impact of UK immigration policy

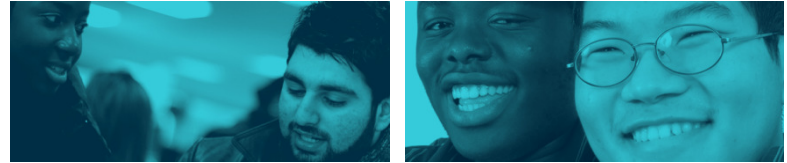
- Next phase: stability, consolidation and partnership...?
