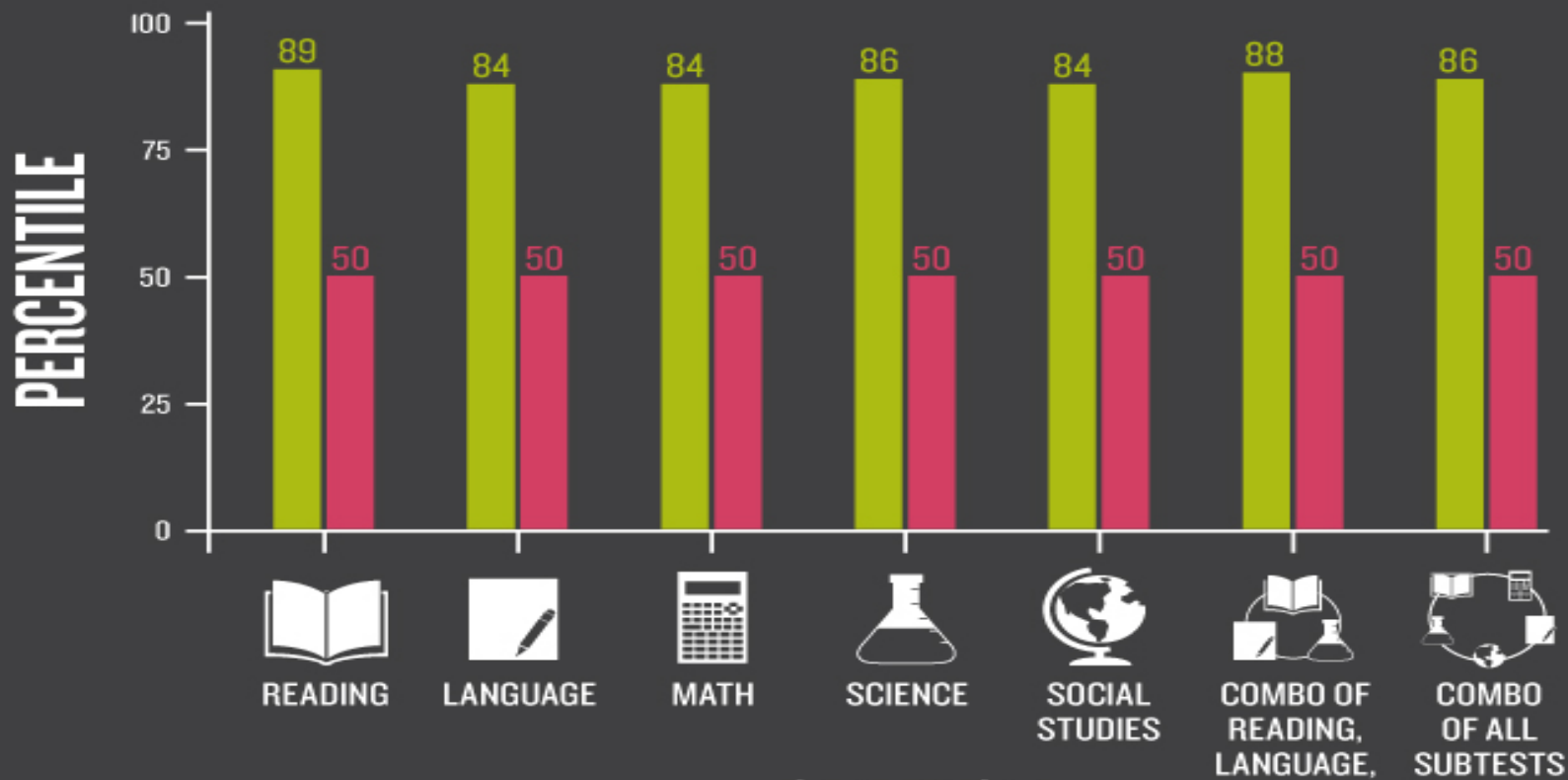

They succeeded **no matter** how much money was spent on their education:

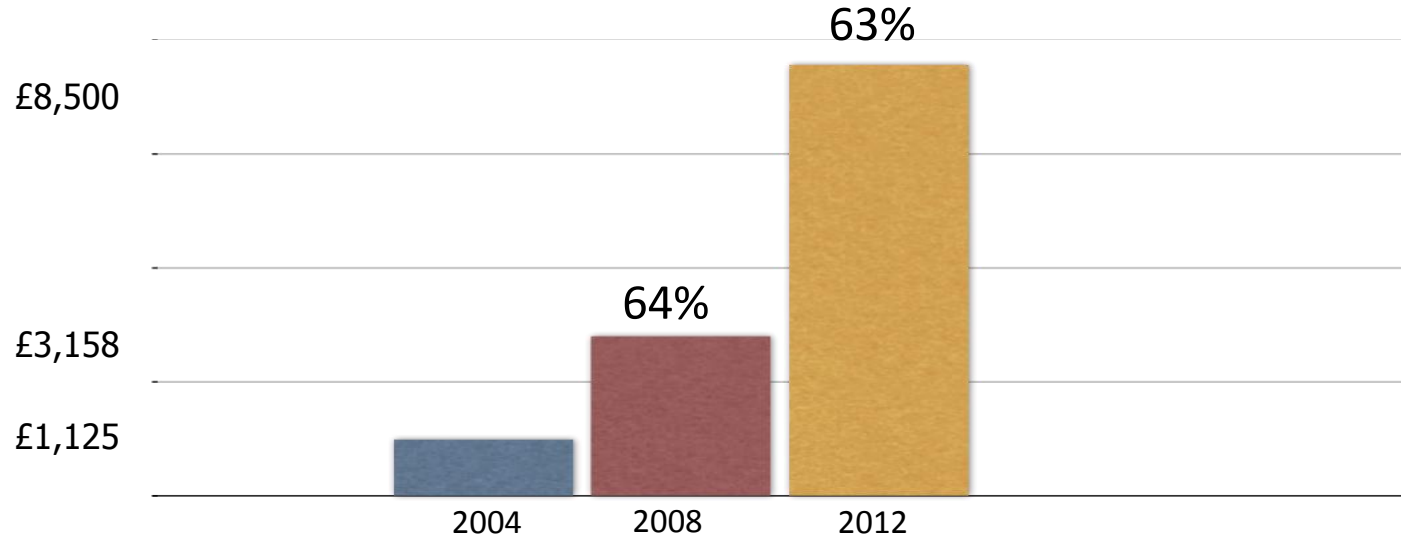

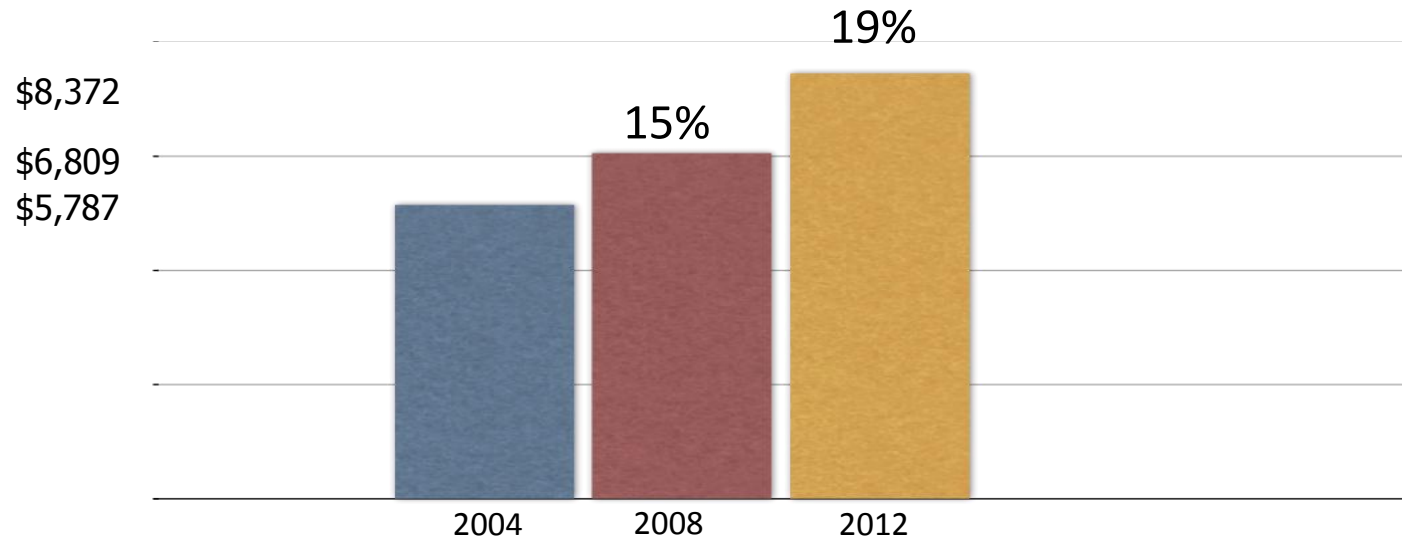

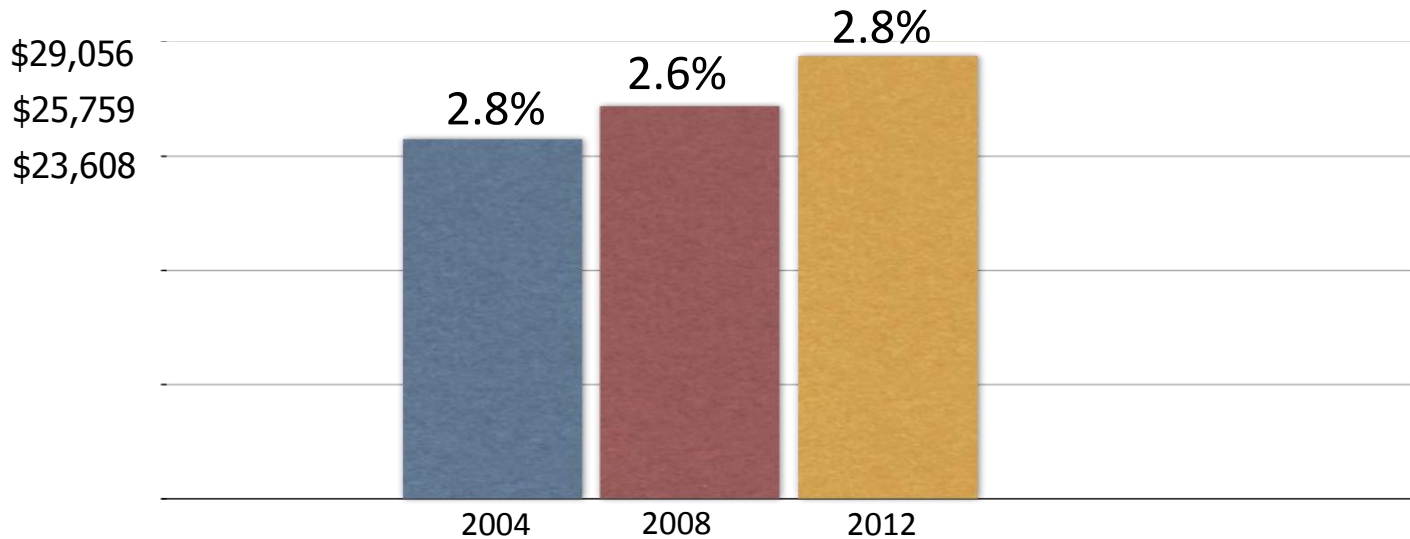

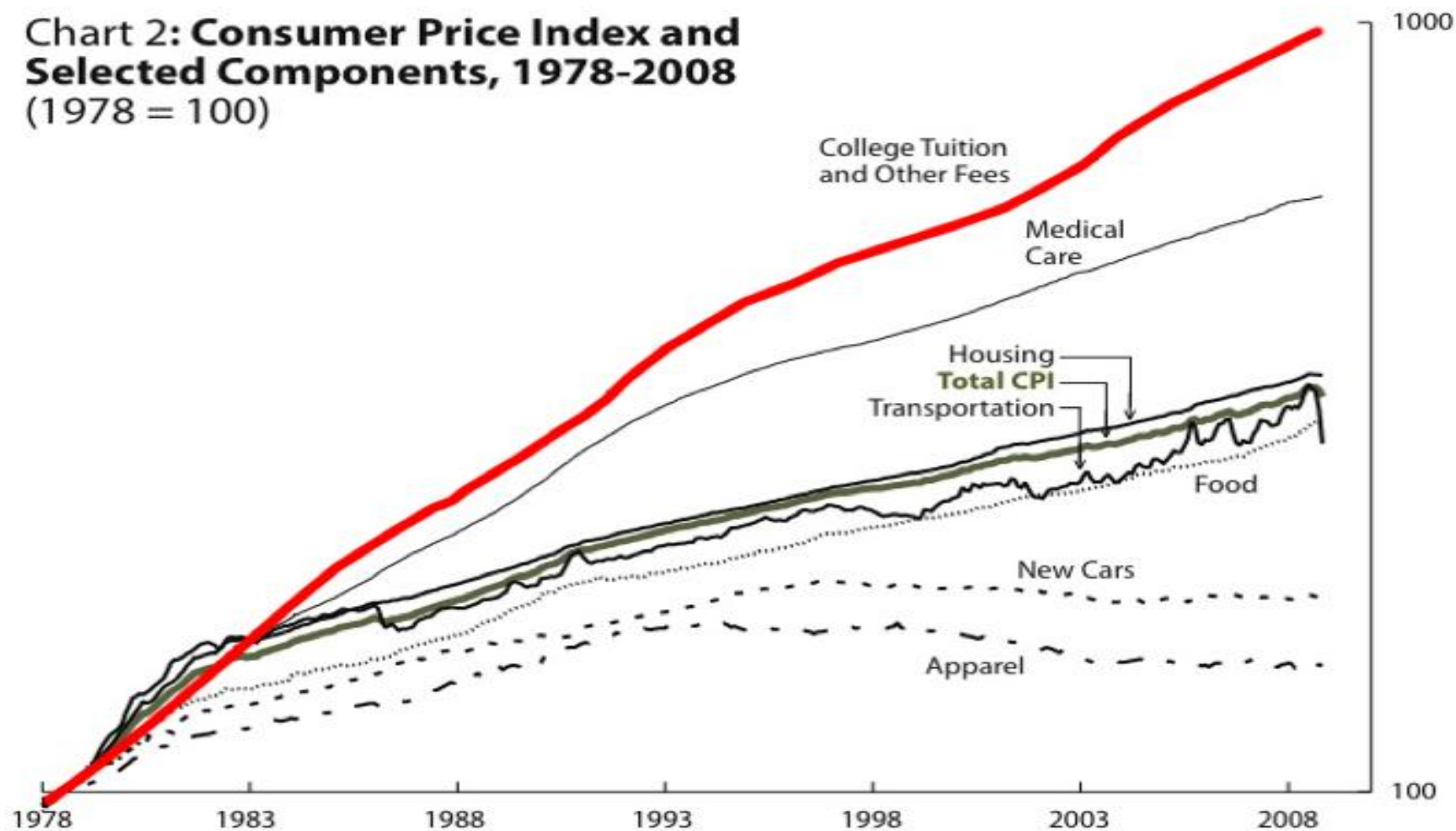

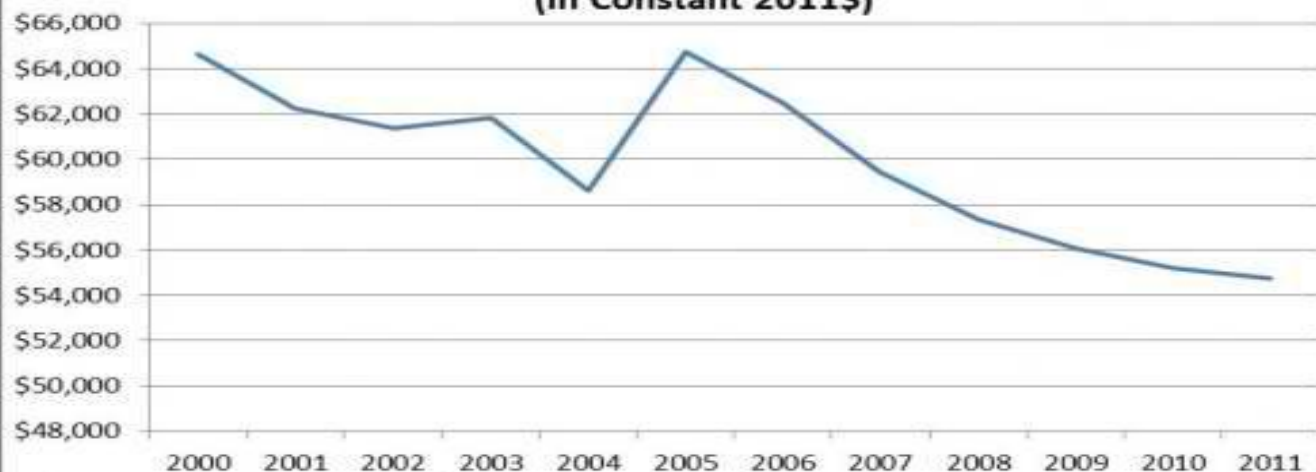
